EQUIPMENTS AND DRUGS NEEDED:

Any Diagnostic Medical Equipment: Mammogram units, Breast Ultrasound unit, Radiotherapy unit, CT scan, MRI, X-Rays, EKG machines, Ophthalmic Operating Microscope etc.

Chemotherapy drugs: Cyclophosphamide inj, 5-FU inj, Epirubicin inj, Docetaxel inj, Letrozole/Tamoxifen tabs and Trastuzumab; HPV Vaccines;

Others: Eye glasses from +1.0DS to 4.0DS, Anti allergy Eye drops, Artificial tears Eye drops, Antibiotic eye drops, NSAID Eye drops, Steroid eye drops & ointments, Atropine eye drops, Testing kits like Glucometers with supplies, Syringes and needles, Alcohol swabs, Band-Aids, Bandages, Gauze and dressing supplies, Wheel chairs, Tongue depressors, Basic suture supplies, Stethoscopes, Basic Sphygmomanometers, Thermometers, Pen, Lights, Urine testing kits, Q-tips, Cotton balls, Prenatal Vitamins, Multivitamins, hypertensive medications, diabetic medications, pain, basic antibiotics, NSAIDs, Analgesics, Wound cleansing supplies, Pens and other writing materials, eye charts, clip boards, note pads, health educational supplies, Keflex, Neosporin ointment or triple antibiotic ointment and wound dressing bandages, Foot ulcers medications, Over the counter Medications (OTC) etc.
