We made these changes to better serve our community during this difficult time.

Our Community Adoption Partnership Program will enable the cancer & maternal health indigent members to easily access healthcare, be healthier, reduce avoidable deaths and this will promote economic productivity in Anambra State and the Nation at Large. **Our Funding amount is from \$5,000 to \$50,000** and our goal is to enroll 100 indigent members a year for 5 years in the State's Health Insurance Scheme, while supporting the expansion of a Community's Health Centre into a Cancer Treatment/ Diagnostic Centre in Anambra State-Nigeria
